Blue Beech/Musclewood

Carpinus caroliniana

- The pretty leaves open chartreuse in spring and filter light into a golden shade that is one of this trees most attractive attributes. The autumn color is a subtle orange to yellow and, as the leaves are small, there is rarely much litter in winter.
- Blue Beech is a native, large shrub or small tree with a widespreading, flat-topped crown,
- Seeds, buds and catkins are eaten by songbirds, ruffed grouse, ring-necked pheasants, bobwhite and turkey


