- Greens up early in the spring and grows very well in open woods and woodland margins.
- Makes a nice soft woodland groundcover. To use as a turf grass, mow 2-3 times a year, when about 3-4" tall.
- Will grow in full sun if irrigated. Suitable for sandy soil.
- Native to Ontario, Quebec & Manitoba
