Titania Currant

Ribes nigrum 'Titania'

- Clusters of yellow-green flowers give way to firm, round, glossy black fruit that is ready to harvest in mid to late summer
- Fast growing variety that blooms late protecting the blossoms from freezing. Leaves are aromatic when crushed.
- Black currants, although tart, may be eaten ripe off the shrub, but are perhaps more often harvested to make jams, jellies, pies and freeze well.
