## Wild Grape

Vitis riparia

- Green flowers bloom in spring and summer followed by fruit varying in colour from black to purple to amber from August to October.
- Woody climber, grown for its edible (but sour) grapes. Leaves are finetipped, with coarsely toothed margins and heart shaped bases.
- Best fruiting in full sun, in well drained soil, but tolerates light shade & heavier soils. Good drainage is a must, and protection from harsh winds
- Native to Ontario & Quebec
